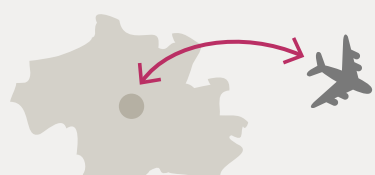

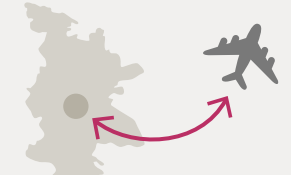

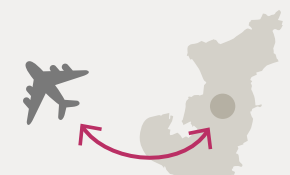
Fly high - Bavarian airports

60,000 take-offs and landings*

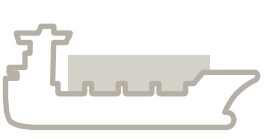


MEMMINGEN (FMM)

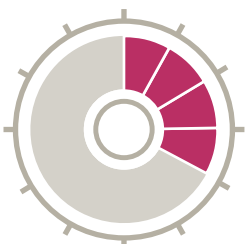

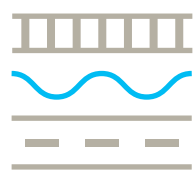
ROAD NETWORK:
